Interface description of the connection to  
OUTTRA Brand WTB (stores)

### Connection to the OUTTRA Brand WTB interface (stores)

To connect your store(s) to the OUTTRA Brand WTB interface, we need a CSV file that is updated several times a day and contains all available articles of your store(s) of the corresponding brand. It is important that this CSV file is updated several times a day on your server. We will download this CSV file every two to three hours from your server via a download link and integrate it into our system.

For the connection to the interface, a CSV file with several columns is required. The name and the order of the columns are not relevant.

A UTF-8 encoding should be used.

#### Fields

- **gtin**  
The GTIN / EAN of the corresponding variant should be specified in this column.
- **name (optional)**  
The name of the article variant must be in this column.
- **brand (optional)**  
The brand of the article variant must be in this column.
- **store1 ... storeN (optional)**  
If you want to transfer several store stocks in one CSV file, you can do this using individual columns. For each GTIN/EAN, enter the stocks of the respective store in the corresponding column.
- **stock (optional)**  
Here you can transfer the stock amount you have for this product in the specific store.
